

Rules and regulations

These regulations are necessary for the campsite's good organization. The management kindly demands you to study and observe them, in order to make your stay here as pleasant as possible.

Admission conditions

Without the manager's or his delegate's authorisation, you do not have the right to penetrate, build up camping equipment and stay on the campsite. The manager is obliged to run the campsite correctly, to maintain order and to make sure the rules and regulations are observed. By staying on camping *La Salendrinque* you automatically accept the dispositions of these regulations as well as their observation.

Formalities of your stay

Arrival hours: Between 2pm and 8pm, 3pm and 8pm for the accommodations.

Any person who stays for at least one night has to show the management his identity papers and to fill out the registration form that is demanded by the police.

The tent or caravan with accessory material has to be installed on the indicated pitch in accordance with the manager's or his delegate's instructions.

Departure hours: Between 7:30am and 10am for the accommodations; or the day before until 10pm (no departures during the night) and before 11am for the pitches, unless the management has given a special authorization. Camping guests are kindly asked to check out the day before their departure.

In case of early departure or late arrival, the total booked stay will be invoiced. Your pitch or accommodation will be reserved for 24 hours after the booked arrival date. After this period we will dispose of it. Please notify us of any change of your arrival date.

Installation

Every pitch can hold one single tent, caravan or motor home. However, a small extra tent may be added after the management's with the management's agreement.

Entrance fee:

Due fees are calculated dependent on camping material, the number of persons and the number of nights spent on the campsite. Prices are indicated at the reception and at the entrance. They are all included, except for tourism taxes.

Reception

The reception's opening hours are indicated at the entrance.

Here you will find all useful information for smooth holidays: The campsite's services, information about tourist trips and sport activities in the area.

Visitors

Visitors are allowed on the campsite and fall under responsibility of the camping guests who receive them. Every visitor pays an entrance fee upon arrival; tariffs are indicated at the entrance of the campsite and at the reception. The visitors' cars must stay in the car park.

Noise nuisance

Camping guests must try not to disturb their neighbours (Be careful with e.g. radios, TVs, closing car doors)

Total silence must reign between 10:30pm and 7:30am.

Traffic and parking

On the campsite the speed limit is 10km / H, for everyone's safety and comfort.

It is strictly prohibited to drive between **10pm and 7:30am**; cars must be parked in the car park.

The car must be parked on the camping guest's pitch or in a car park. A car must never hinder newcomers' installation on other pitches. Only resident's cars are allowed to enter the campsite.

Pets

Dogs from category 1 and 2 are prohibited

Only tattooed and vaccinated pets are accepted, after showing the pet passport.

They must be leashed. No animal can stay on the campsite without his owner's presence, not even when locked in.

Sanitary buildings and common areas are prohibited for pets.

The pet's droppings will be disposed of by its owner.

The owners are always legally responsible for their pets.

Young children

Young children must always be watched by their parents, who have civil liability in case of an accident.

Playing

Violent games or games that bother other camping guests are prohibited in the area of the sanitary buildings.

Hygiene and respect for the campsite

It is in anyone's interest to keep the campsite hygienic and clean:

Waste water will only be emptied in the special service area.

Rubbish and other waste will be disposed of in the different containers on the car park (Waste sorting)

The dishes will be done in the appropriate sink.

As well as laundry will be done in the appropriate laundry wash basins

Clothes-lines must not hinder the neighbours. Trees will not be used as drying racks.

It is forbidden to damage trees (do not hammer in nails, don't cut branches)

All degradation of the vegetation or of the camping installations, will be at the expense of its perpetrator.

Security

Fire : Open fire is strictly prohibited, including charcoal barbecues.

Camping stoves must be correctly kept in order.

Fire extinguishers are available at the camp site.

A fire :

Avoid panic.

When a fire just starts, anyone can put it out.

Warn:

- Management
- The fire brigade (18)
- Use the fire extinguishers

Meet at the gathering point on the car park by following the red arrows.

Theft:

Management is responsible for things that have been deposited at the reception and has a general obligation to supervise. The camping guest stays responsible for his own camping material and has to point any suspect person to the campsite manager. Even if there is supervision, we invite our guests to take all usual precautions for the protection of their material.

Payment

Payment can be made by check, credit card or cash.

The total amount of the stay will be paid on the day of arrival.

Breach of the rules and regulations

Should a camping guest disturb other guests' stay or disobey the dispositions of these rules and regulations, than the camping manager or his delegate could order him to cease the disturbances. In case of repeated and serious breach of these rules and regulations and after the manager's summons to observe them, he could end the stay of the camping guest and his companions. In case there is a breach of the law, the manager could call upon the police.
